## GROUP COUNSELING SPECIALTIES

**STRIVING TO END ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIPS (STEAR)** is a 26-week program that focuses on relationship violence and forming healthy relationships. Service is provided to victims and perpetrators of domestic violence. The program cost includes a \$35 fee for the initial assessment, and \$25 per session. Cash only paid at the time of service.

**PRACTICING ANGER CONTROL EFFECTIVELY (PACE)** is a 16-week program designed to help participants learn to cope with anger in everyday life. Topics include identifying your anger cycle, recognizing the signs, taking ownership of consequences, and learning to solve problems without anger. The program cost includes a \$35 fee for the initial assessment, and \$25 per session. Cash only paid at the time of service.

**PARENTING CLASSES** are offered in an 8-week program designed to help parents and caregivers learn more about raising their children. Topics include understanding yourself and your child, listening and talking, cooperation, discipline that makes sense, and more. The program costs \$15 per session to be paid in cash at the time of service.

The Family Counseling Center of Anderson (FCC) is a community-based mental health counseling program, and is open to the public. FCC fulfills the counseling needs of children, adults, and families throughout Anderson and surrounding counties.

For more than forty years, FCC has provided therapeutic and intervention services to children, adolescents and families with behavioral and emotional challenges.

All clinicians are licensed to practice independently in South Carolina. Licensed staff members include Licensed Independent Social Workers-Clinical Practice (LISW-CP), Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFT), and Licensed Professional Counselors (LPC). Masters-level interns are also available to provide quality services at a reduced rate.

FCC provides affordable and accessible to all at reasonable rates. Medicaid and most major insurances are accepted. FCC is a United Way funded program.
